

Guillaume Prunier appointed Special Advisor to the President

In 2014, he has been promoted to advisor in the cabinet of Emmanuel Macron, then Minister for Economic Affairs. Guillaume was in charge of innovation, entrepreneurship and SMEs. After having contributed to the business development of a software unicorn, Guillaume became in 2017 CEO of Flaminem, a startup specialized in Big Data analysis and artificial intelligence. In 2019, he joined INRIA, the French national research institute in computer sciences, as deputy CEO.

Eukarÿs is a French biotechnology company from the Biocluster de la Genopole d'Evry which is developing the first, and to date the only, eukaryotic artificial expression system called C3P3. This system enables high-yield production of mature messenger RNA and therefore proteins of interest in the host cell. Thanks to this system, Eukarÿs is developing a radically innovative approach to synthetic gene therapy, which provides solutions to the challenges facing this new therapeutic area. Eukarÿs also uses the C3P3 system to develop high-performance bioproduction systems for biological drugs including proteins, recombinant viruses and VLP-type vaccines.
